There is a parking garage within walking distance, which we can reserve for your guests. Tram and bus stops are located in front of the museum entrance.

During the museum's opening hours (Tuesday - Sunday 10:00 - 17:00 hrs), our caterer CateringMeesters will take care of your food and beverages. GARDEN GALLERY



Hosting the final press conference of the Nuclear Security Summit in 2014, former president of the USA, Barack Obama opened our beautiful Garden Gallery in what was previously a modern courtyard. The Garden Gallery hosts up to 700 guests, but it is also suitable for small groups because of its intimate atmosphere, excellent acoustics and pleasant climate. Through the windows of the Garden Gallery in the heart of the museum your guests have a view on the surrounding exhibition spaces.
