Location and parking

The Kunstmuseum is centrally located between The Hague city centre and the beaches of Scheveningen. There is sufficient street parking available in front of the museum and in the immediate surroundings (paid from 13:00 - 00:00 hrs). There is a parking garage within walking distance, which we can reserve for your guests. Tram and bus stops are located directly opposite our entrance.

Catering and technical support

During the museum's opening hours (Tuesday to Sunday 10.00 - 17.00 hrs), our partner CateringMeesters will take care of the catering for your event. Outside of opening hours, you are welcome to use a caterer of your choice, in consultation with the museum. For technical support we recommend our preferred partner Bourgonje.

Enrich your event with a visit to one of our exhibitions. We can provide guided tours and/or introductory art talks by museum experts. Visit one of our permanent exhibitions, such as Mondriaan & De Stijl, Delftware WonderWare, Discover the modern or one of our temporary exhibitions. 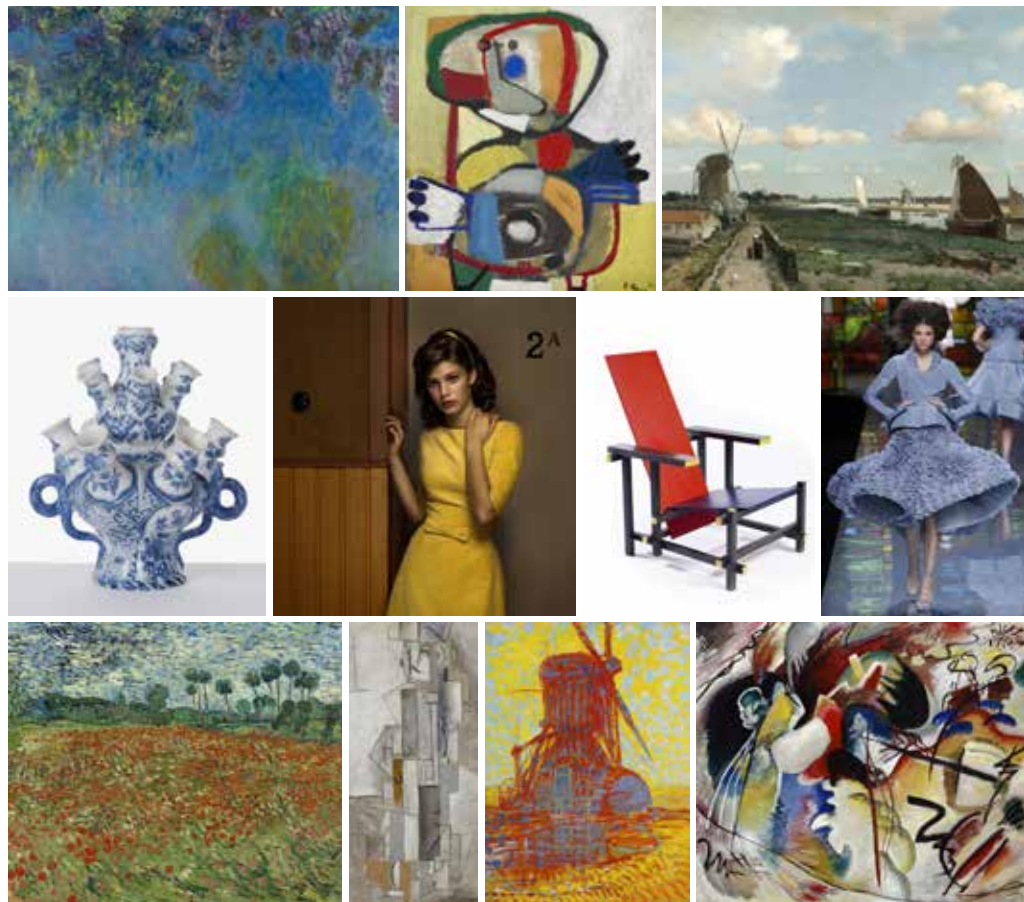
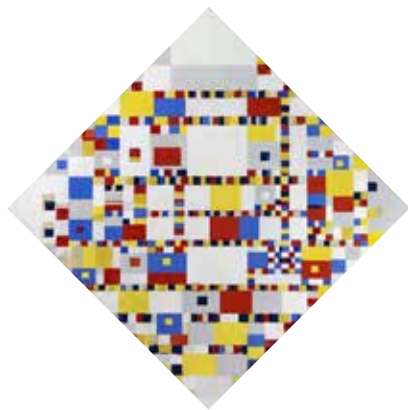

Garden Gallery

In the Garden Gallery, formerly the courtyard garden, you are literally surrounded by the beautiful Berlage building and the arts: the windows of the Garden Gallery offer a view on the surrounding exhibition spaces. With its excellent acoustics and pleasant indoor climate, the Garden Gallery is suitable for both intimate and larger gatherings. You can receive up to 700 guests here.

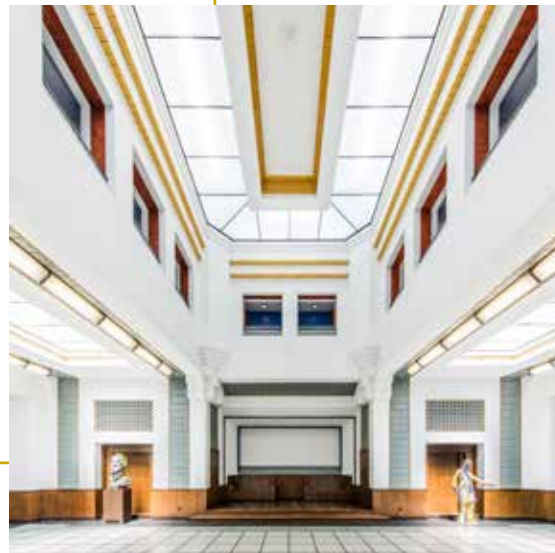


Grand Hall

Your guests will marvel at the grandeur of the Grand Hall and feel surrounded by the arts. The Grand hall offers a spectacular backdrop for your event but can also function as an additional space that offers your guests a grand entrance or an unforgettable farewell to your event.

Honour Gallery

The Honour Gallery is an intimate space to host your event in the heart of Berlage's architecture with an exquisite view of the Hall below. This space is located between two galleries with temporary exhibitions. Your guests can conveniently be taken for a guided tour.



Auditorium

Use our Auditorium to tell your story in a lecture, a presentation or a concert. The fixed theatre setting is spread over two floors: 150 seats on the ground floor and 50 seats on the balcony. All basic AV resources are available.

Fotomuseum/KM21

Fotomuseum Den Haag, right next to the Kunstmuseum, shares a building with KM21, exhibition space for contemporary art, and restaurant Gember. The Fotomuseum has staged a large number of memorable exhibitions: Man Ray, Sally Mann, Anton Corbijn, Erwin Olaf, Michael Wolf and Robin de Puy, to name a few examples.
